## SCHEDULE — QUESTIONS

### Oral Questions

- 123/2017 Hon. Ro Teimumu Kepa to ask the Minister for Local Government, Housing, Environment, Infrastructure and Transport – Sunken derelict ships in Suva Harbour pose a danger to maritime navigation and are the cause of much pollution from their deteriorating hulls to the unknown nature of their cargo as well as the release of fuel and oil into the maritime environment. Can the Minister explain what the Ministry is doing about this.
- 124/2017 Hon. Semesa Karavaki to ask the Minister for Local Government, Housing, Environment, Infrastructure and Transport – Can the Minister advise this House what is the progress on the relocation of the jetty from Tubou Village.
- 125/2017 Hon. Mikaele Leawere to ask the Minister for Education, Heritage and Arts – The Certificate Course in Commercial Farming conducted at FNU commenced in 2014 and now it has stopped. Students were promised a piece of land and \$75,000.00 as operating funds. Can the Minister inform this House the current status of this programme.
- 126/2017 Hon. Mataiasi Niumataiwalu to ask the Attorney-General and Minister for Economy, Public Enterprises, Civil Services and Communications – Access to climate finance is something Fiji and small vulnerable states have been trying to access for over a long period of time through the Conference of Parties. Just a week ago we had the High level Pacific Island Dialogue on Building Resilience to Natural Disaster and Climate Change – Can the Minister inform this House as in what ways can we gain access to Climate Finance.
- 127/2017 Hon. Howard Politini to ask the Minister for Defence and National Security – Can the Minister inform the House of the exit strategy that the Republic of Fiji Military Forces has in place for our soldiers serving in the Middle East should tensions escalate to a level that threatens the safety of our people in mission areas.

128/2017 Hon. Netani Rika to ask the Minister for Fisheries – Can the Minister enlighten the House on what the offshore fishing division of the Ministry’s latest initiative in monitoring, control and surveillance in the offshore sector.

129/2017 Hon. Prem Singh to ask the Minister for Local Government, Housing, Environment, Infrastructure and Transport – Would the Minister inform Parliament the total output of electricity of all generators purchased by the Fiji Electricity Authority to date.
